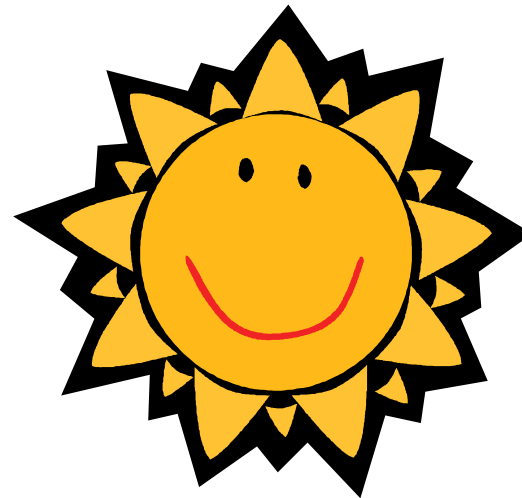

IT'S A SUMMER EXTRAVAGANZA!

We are excited about sharing the wonderful experiences available to children in Daycroft Montessori School's 2009 summer program. Come and spend your summer with us as we engage in an extravaganza of activities, ranging from art in all forms imaginable, games, legos, gardening, computers, cooking: we have it all! Some classes include field trips. So join us for the whole summer or just a few weeks, but be sure you do not miss out on all the fun!

Two age groups are available for each class this summer, Kindergarten through second grade (K-2) and third grade through sixth grade (3-6). The activities described in this brochure are designed for those skill levels. A few classes are offered for kindergarten through sixth grade (K to 6).

Included in the cost of camp is:

- A summer camp t-shirt for each camper the first week of their summer fun experience.
- Cheese pizza lunch each Friday of summer camp with a beverage (fruit juice) and frozen dessert.

SACK LUNCHES will be offered Monday through Thursday by Main Dish. **The cost will be \$5 per sack lunch.** Please see the back of the registration form for the lunch order form if you are interested. Each will include an entrée, two sides and a beverage.

SUMMER PROGRAM INFORMATION

Daycroft Montessori School offers a 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 or 11 week plan for children at the Zeeb campus. When choosing an appropriate summer program plan, please enroll your child in the class that she/he will be entering in the fall of 2009: Kindergarten through second grade (K-2) or Grades three through six (3-6).

Back to the Garden with Maty Hamilton (K-6)

We will be spending significant time in the school's organic garden learning skills such as: composting, cultivation of vegetables and flowers, and garden maintenance. There will be a field trip to the Ann Arbor Farmers Market and to the University of Michigan Botanical gardens as well as the stunning Nichol's Arboretum. We will be learning about Michigan's native wildlife and plants with lots of hands-on activities. Get ready to get dirty and have fun!

LEGO Engineering with All for Learning (K-2 and 3-6)

Using LEGO Educational Division Material and LEGO Technic elements, your child will learn by doing. The course covers gears, levers, wheels, axles, structures, forces and simple machines. This is an integrated science and math class.

Lego Vehicles with All for Learning (K-2 and 3-6)

NEW

In this class students will use advanced LEGO kits design and construct the car of your dreams! The AM class will build many different vehicles which will include, Car, Golf Cart, Model "A" Ford, Semi Truck and Trailer, Rubber Band Trigger Car, Snow Plow, Motorized Shopping Cart, Stand Up Scooter and more. The PM class will build many different vehicles also capped off with a final project. Projects include, Adjustable Crane, Bobcat, Flipper Car, Forklift, space Cruiser, Submarine and many more.

Set Your "Sites" High with Mandi Tuite (3-8)

Learn how to build your own website! During this week your child will learn step by step how to make their own Web page and publish it on the World Wide Web. We will explore how websites are built, maintained, approved and monitored. We will explore the ideas of creating websites for communication, financial gain, research and advertisement/promotion of goods.

Comic Book Creations with Mandi Tuite (3-8)

NEW

Ever wonder how artists come up with such wonderful drawings or how the author comes up with such action packed stories. Wonder no more. During this week you will create your very own comic book story and create your own art. Learn about the history of comics and how to create a comic. You will also meet some current comic artists and developers working right here in Ann Arbor.

Little Chefs with Maty Hamilton (K-6)

Your child will discover the amazing textures, colors and flavors of food. They will take a field trip to the market and create a variety of culinary wonders including lunch meals, simple snacks and easy to make dinners. They will also learn about kitchen safety under the supervision of Ms. Maty.

Global Children with Maty Hamilton (K-2) NEW

Experience the food, culture, music and cuisine from a wide variety of countries touching all parts of the globe. Projects and art related to these countries will ensue and make this week an unforgettable experience for your children.

Calling all Game Masters with Mandi Tuite (3-8) NEW

Want to know how video and computer games are designed, who plays them and where, and in what ways they can be more than just for your entertainment? Learn how to develop your own video/computer game. We will explore the evolution of games and how the virtual world has influenced the board game world. Get ready to put your game to the test and step into a virtual world of imagination and creativity.

Montessori Matters with Jeanine Wright (K-4)

This class will introduce the student to Montessori materials in the classroom. This class is a must for any new students to Daycroft, or those new to the Zeeb Campus, or for anyone interested in the Montessori approach to learning.

Recreation with Mandi Tuite (K-6)

Students will participate in all kinds of physical activity in a structured environment. Be prepared to play games such as soccer and baseball, have fun in the sprinkler and test your running skills.

Frogs, Salamanders and Ponds with Saki Rahman (K-2)

Ramble around the backyard ponds...toss in a net...what have we here? Try fishing for fun with critters expert Paul McCormick! Connect with nature.. What types? Where? Let's research and prepare a nature scrapbook. Collect specimens and more.

International Cooking with Maty Gomez-Hamilton (K-6)

Discover easy to make recipes from five different countries: Iran, Mexico, Peru, Thailand and Spain. The recipes will include an explanation of the original ingredients required for each. Let you taste buds travel around the world with this delightful culinary experience.

Chess Camp and Games with Ray Garrison (K-6)

Learn how to play chess or simply improve your skills. Play dozens of thinking games, traditional and abstract modern. Go, Othello, Stratego, Risk, chess variants etc, a different tournament every day. Everyone is guaranteed a trophy.

Amazing Authors with Saki Rahman (K-2)

Wander into the world of folklore and fables! Have fun with a variety of Book bags. Feel inspired to write and illustrate your own tale in a Big Book, create a pop-up book and share a poem. Design and build small scale sculptures, imaginative lands and costumes with a wide range of materials ranging from wood and metal to foam and cloth.

Join us for a week full of creative options. Children will be able to create at the creation station with a vast number of construction materials, clay, paper and paints, shrinky dinks and much more. Experiment at the science station, learning through hands-on investigation of magnets, bubbles, circuits, bubble gum and more. Publish at the reader's station by creating books, hunting for letters, playing alphabet hopscotch, accessing high quality literature and much more.

Painting with Suzanne Higgins (K-2)
